thrilled to announce that, thanks to the incredible support from our community, we've had the privilege of serving more than 28,750 campers since our doors opened in 2006. Last year marked a milestone as we welcomed 1,839 campers from 49 diverse partner groups – our largest turnout yet! Even with a 40% growth in campers, our team's commitment to ensuring each camper feels welcomed and loved remained unwavering.

Our 2023 post-camp surveys revealed:

- 84% of campers felt they belonged in the camp community;
- 87% of campers made at least two great friends; and
- 74% of campers felt more confident as a result of their time at camp.
